



TULIP SQUARE PATTERNS

PIN CUSHION LADIES

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MATERIALS NEEDED TO MAKE A PIN CUSHION LADY:

2 oz. of polymer clay in the fleshtone of your choice

Small bits of colored polymer clay for eyes and lips

Clay tools of your choice

Gloss glaze for eyes and lips

Small amount of yarn for hair - wool, acrylic, variegated, etc

5 inch wooden base

Polymer stuffing

White glue or tacky glue

Strong thread or string

Assorted thread or floss to match hair and clothing

Small basket - purchased, crocheted, knit, etc

Fabric remnants (see pattern pieces for amounts needed)

Optional buttons and trims as you want

Shawl is either a piece of fabric, or a weaving remnant, or you can knit or crochet a small shawl, rectangle or triangle. Size will depend on the thickness of your yarn, so this needs to be adjusted once your lady is assembled and you can try them on her.
